Dear parents/carers,

Last week, the children took part in activities to promote 'One Kind Word' which was the theme for Anti-Bullying week. They discussed what bullying is and understood that it has a clear definition. As a school, we follow the definition that they Anti-Bullying Alliance promote:

Bullying is the repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. It can happen face to face or online.

Staff take concerns of bullying very seriously and will investigate any issues raised. Children are aware that sometimes they may fall out with a friend, however this is not bullying.

Pupils spent last week using kind words and the expectation is that this will continue. Anti-bullying issues were the focus of the week; however the children will continue to apply what they have learnt to school and home life even after the week.

We ask parents to be vigilant with online activity. The children are aware of online dangers and how to report worries but we do ask parents to monitor online usage very closely. There is guidance on the school website to support parents with online usage.
