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Let's take a look at what our Y5's have been up to this week...

In English, we have been learning about modal verbs. We have learned that they are auxiliary verbs which cannot usually work alone. They are used with a main verb. Modal verbs can make questions by inversion and can be used to show how possible something is, or how likely it is to happen/have happened. We went into the hall this lesson and took part in Active English. We organised words and phrases into nouns, adjectives, verbs, and modal verbs in groups.
